CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

PERRY HOUSER  
PILOT ROCK, OR 97868

confirms the right to use the waters of EAST BIRCH CREEK, a tributary of BIRCH CREEK, for IRRIGATION of 15.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-137. The date of priority is JUNE 7, 1909. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.195 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officers.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 434, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT transferred or cancelled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered Aug 30 2012, approving Transfer Application T-11346. The certificate also clarifies the stream to which East Birch Creek is a tributary.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.
