CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

T. F. McCALLISTER  
PRINEVILLE, OR 97754

confirms the right to use the waters of WHYCHUS CREEK (formerly Squaw Creek), a tributary of the DESCHUTES RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 57.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director, in Volume 1, at Page 471. The date of priority is 1901.

The use is limited to 1.14 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (cfs) or its equivalent in case of rotation measured at the point of diversion from the source.

A description of the place to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 68134, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 28 2012, and recorded in Special Order Volume 88, Pages 413 to 414, canceling a portion of the water right. This certificate supersedes Certificate 68134.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
