 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

EASTERN OREGON EXPERIMENT STATION
 372 S. TENTH STREET; P.O. BOX E
 UNION, OREGON 97883

confirms the right to use the waters of CATHERINE CREEK and PYLES CANYON, tributary to the GRANDE RONDE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 195.1 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 8, at Page 1. The dates of priority are 1863, 1864 and 1869.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 ACRE-FEET per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
