CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ALFRED A MCCORQUODALE
15646 HWY 99 S
MYRTLE CREEK OR 97457

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, tributary to UMPQUA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 9.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 7528. The date of priority is August 20, 1926. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.12 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
29 S	6 W	WM	12	SE NW	3140 FEET NORTH & 1890 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 12

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old points of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original points of diversion described as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 7, 1997, at Special Order Volume 51, Page 8, approving Transfer Application 7478, and together with Certificate 73635, supersedes Certificate 51323, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
