confirms the right to use the waters of WELL 7 in the SILVER LAKE BASIN for IRRIGATION of 122.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-6670. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 23, 1974. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.52 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the point of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original points of appropriation [prior to an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 10, 1991].

The well at the point of appropriation shall be maintained to the well construction standards in effect as of May 10, 1991, and must include an access port.

When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 76038, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered Nov. (2012) approving Transfer Application T-11322.
