CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

SHOTGUN RANCH LLC
CAL CANNON
2730 NW NIGHTFALL CIRCLE

confirms the right to use the waters of SHOTGUN CREEK, tributary to CROOKED RIVER for IRRIGATION of 15 ACRES AND STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 449. The date of priority is 1889. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.19 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

17 S	20 E	WM	9	SW SW	2040 FEET SOUTH AND 920 FEET EAST FROM W1/4 CORNER, SECTION 9

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The period of use is February 1st until December 1st.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The water user shall maintain the headgate, in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of diversion.

Original point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
17 S	20 E	WM	9	SE NW	1940 FEET SOUTH AND 100 FEET WEST FROM N1/4 CORNER, SECTION 9

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in PLACE OF USE, POINT OF DIVERSION, approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 22, 2006, at Special Order Volume 68, Page 761, approving Transfer Application 9908, and together with Certificate 81673, supersedes Certificate 515, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
