CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CGC INCORPORATED CRYSTAL SPRINGS 500 SE BUTLER RD GRESHAM OR 97080

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM AND RESERVOIRS C & D, CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-11469, TRIBUTARIES OF JOHNSON CREEK, FOR IRRIGATION OF 129.66 ACRES, AND AN UNNAMED STREAM, AND HOGAN CREEK, A TRIBUTARY OF JOHNSON CREEK, FOR MAINTENANCE OF RESERVOIRS A & B FOR AESTHETICS.

This right was perfected under Permit S-51488. The date of priority is MAY 24, 1991. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 1.84 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 1.62 CFS FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.22 CFS FOR MAINTENANCE OF PONDS FOR AESTHETICS, AND 12.88 ACRE FEET (AF), BEING 1.76 AF FROM RESERVOIR C, AND 11.12 AF FROM RESERVOIR D FOR IRRIGATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion from the sources.

The appropriation of water from direct flow is limited to the period of December 1 through June 1 of each year.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage.

This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land, including the

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484 and ORS 536.075. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 183.484, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate within three months after issuance of the certificate.
