CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of THREE WELLS in the WILLAMETTE BASIN for PRIMARY IRRIGATION OF 57.7 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 10.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10764. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 25, 1987. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.846 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The wells shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The water user shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device and keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 83034, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered 12-21-2012, approving Transfer Application T-10933.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
