CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

PINE HOLLOW COOPERATIVE INC.

confirms the right to use the waters of BADGER CREEK WHEN AVAILABLE WITH ANY DEFICIENCY IN THE AVAILABLE SUPPLY FROM BADGER CREEK TO BE MADE UP BY APPROPRIATION FROM THREEMILE CREEK, THEN BADGER LAKE RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-773 THEN PINE HOLLOW RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-5250, for IRRIGATION of 319.61 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-50066. The date of priority is JANUARY 3, 1986. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 8.00 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion (POD) are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484 and ORS 536.075. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 183.484, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate within three months after issuance of the certificate.
