CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STATE OF OREGON
WATER RESOURCES DEPARTMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of JOHN DAY RIVER, tributary to COLUMBIA RIVER, for instream use for conservation, maintenance and enhancement of aquatic and fish life, wildlife, fish and wildlife habitat and other ecological values.

This right was perfected under Permit S-2355. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 9, 1915. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used, and shall not exceed 0.79 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion, from April 1 through September 30.

The description of the stream point at which flows are to be maintained is at the location of the diversion point previously authorized under Certificate 87511, located approximately at:

At the specified stream point, the amount of water to which this right is entitled shall not exceed the quantity of water legally available at the original point of diversion.


Water rights upstream of the original point of diversion shall not be subject to regulation for flows in excess of the quantities to which this instream water right is entitled at the original point of diversion.

The instream right established by this transfer shall replace a portion of instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.341 or 537.346 and shall be in addition to instream water rights established pursuant to ORS 537.348 or 537.470, unless otherwise specified by a subsequent order establishing a new instream water right.

The right is subject to all other terms and conditions of Certificate 87511, and any related decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in use and place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director recorded in Special Order Volume 78, Page 208, approving Transfer T-11303, and supersedes Certificate 87511, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
