CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of SUMP 1 with any deficiency in the available supply from SUMP 1 to be made up by diversion from SUMP 2 for IRRIGATION of 5.55 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-9745. The date of priority is AUGUST 21, 1981. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.07 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, measured at the sumps.

The wells (sumps) are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The wells (sumps) shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484 and ORS 536.075. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 183.484, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied. In addition, under ORS 537.260 any person with an application, permit or water right certificate subsequent in priority may jointly or severally contest the issuance of the certificate within three months after issuance of the certificate.

The water user shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device and keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.
