CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MAXWELL DAIRY
304 DAIRY LOOP RD
ROSEBURG OR 97470

confirms the right to use the waters of LOOKINGGLASS CREEK, tributary to SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 16.7 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-25902. The date of priority is DECEMBER 17, 1958. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.21 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the points of diversion.

The points of diversion (POD) are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The right to the use of water is limited to the period when the flow of water in the South Umpqua River is 60.0 CFS or more at its mouth.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and an additional point of diversion approved by orders of the Water Resources Director entered July 26, 1988, at Special Order Volume 42, Page 302, approving Transfer Application 6020, entered March 8, 1990, at Special Order Volume 44, Page 120, approving Transfer Application 6300, and together with Certificate 57718, supersedes Certificate 33016, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
