CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

SUCCESSORS TO
SQUAW CREEK IRRIGATION COMPANY

confirms the right to use the waters of WHYCHUS CREEK (formerly Squaw Creek), a tributary of the DESCHUTES RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 128.5 ACRES and DOMESTIC USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Crook County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director, in Volume 1, at Page 120. The date of priority is NOVEMBER, 1904.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 2.57 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (cfs) or its equivalent in case of rotation measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FIFTIETH (1/50) of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year

A description of the place to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 74151, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director: entered FEB 23 2013, and recorded in Special Order Volume 89, Pages 10 to 11; canceling a portion of the water right. This certificate supersedes Certificate 74151.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
