confirms the right to use the waters from a PRONG OF CLEAR CREEK, tributary of Pine Creek for Tract No. 2 and PINE CREEK for Tract No. 3 for IRRIGATION of 11.0 ACRES and DOMESTIC AND STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 11, at Page 235. The date of priority is 1882 for Tract No. 2 and 1886 for Tract 3. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed ONE-FORTIETH of once cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion and a total limitation of one acre-foot per acre during July, one acre-foot per acre during August and one-half acre-foot per acre during September of each year.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said Decree.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This Certificate, together with Certificate 87948, supersedes Certificate 10353.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
