The right allowed herein is subject to the maintenance and use of adequate treatment facilities to remove the sediment before returning the water to the stream.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 83470, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered Line 10686, and together with Certificate 87952, supersedes Certificate 83470.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
