CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STEVEN & SANDRA DODSON
61956 LARK RD
LA GRANDE OR 97850

confirms the right to use the waters of GRANDE RONDE RIVER, tributary to SNAKE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 0.67 ACRE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Union County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 8, at Page 1. The date of priority is JUNE 1865.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.017 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point(s) of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

Water shall be acquired from the same source as the original point of diversion.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may either petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion and place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 30, 2001, at Special Order Volume 55, Page 514, approving Transfer Application 8417, and together with Certificate 76929, supersedes Certificate 72347, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
