CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DENNIS & LUELLA ZUVER  
971 SOUTH DEER CREEK ROAD  
ROSEBURG OR 97470

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH FORK DEER CREEK, tributary to DEER CREEK for IRRIGATION of 1.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-44241. The date of priority is MAY 1, 1979. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
27 S	5 W	WM	36	SE SE	10 FEET NORTH AND 265 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 36

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion


The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion and place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered December 22, 2003, at Special Order Volume 58, Page 368, approving Transfer Application 9166, and supercedes Certificate 52760, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
