CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

IRVING & DAWN CANNON  
4188 DEL RIO RD  
ROSEBURG OR 97470

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, tributary to UMPQUA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 0.27 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 24057. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 15, 1956. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.003 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.


This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 20, 1998, at Special Order Volume 52, Page 745, approving Transfer Application 7110, and together with Certificate 75770, supercedes Certificate 28416, State record of Water Right Certificates.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
