CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of UNNAMED STREAM and RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-2663, tributaries to CHEHALEM CREEK for IRRIGATION of 0.6 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit S-27573. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 5, 1961. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit R-2663.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
