CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ALEX BOUTACOFF
1339 OLD HWY 234
EAGLE POINT OR 97524

confirms the right to use the waters of the ROGUE RIVER, tributary to PACIFIC OCEAN for IRRIGATION of 2.1 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1898.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.05 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

35 S	1 W	WM	17	SW SE	1250 FEET NORTH & 1815 FEET WEST FROM SE CORNER, SECTION 17

A description of the place of use is as follows:

35 S	1 W	WM	17	SW SE	1.8
35 S	1 W	WM	17	SE SE	0.3

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.


This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use and point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 8, 1998, at Special Order Volume 52, Page 20, approving Transfer Application 6653, and together with Certificate 75432, supercedes Certificate 15832, State record of Water Right Certificates.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-006-075, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
