CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JENNIFER HUMBERT

MILTON FREEWATER OR 97862

confirms the right to use the waters of 2 WELLS, within the WALLA WALLA RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION of 2.2 ACRES AND INDUSTRIAL USE FOR GRAVEL AND ASPHALT OPERATIONS.

This right was perfected under Permit G-9110. The date of priority is DECEMBER 16, 1980. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.10 cubic foot per second (CFS), being 0.03 CFS for irrigation and 0.07 CFS for industrial use, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use of water from the original well for industrial use is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall be limited to 0.07 cubic foot per second (31.42 gallons per minute) and shall not exceed 17.7 acre feet during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may either petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with that diverted at the old point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation.


When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of appropriation and character of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 28, 2003, at Special Order Volume 57, Page 480, approving Transfer Application 8629, and supercedes Certificate 55623, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
