 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of ROGUE RIVER, tributary to PACIFIC OCEAN for IRRIGATION of 1.0 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit S-298. The date of priority is JULY 26, 1909. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

35 S	1 W	WM	17	NW SE	4	1340 FEET NORTH AND 3190 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 17

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

35 S	1 W	WM	17	SW SE	3	1220 FEET NORTH AND 3090 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 17

The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with ODFW's operational and maintenance standards.

The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion and place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 25, 2008, at Special Order Volume 74, Page 736, approving Transfer Application 9552, and together with Certificate 84123, supercedes Certificate 83466, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
