CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BELL NORTHSIDE, LLC
3461 WACONDA RD
GERVAIS OR 97026

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL 2, within the WILLAMETTE RIVER BASIN for INDUSTRIAL USE.

This right was perfected under Permit G-12141. The date of priority is AUGUST 26, 1993. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.11 cubic foot per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the meter or other suitable measuring device in good working order.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- C. The Director may require the water user to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the water user to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the water user to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the right. The Director may provide an opportunity for the water user to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may either petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use, without waste, on the lands or place of use described. The water user is advised that new regulations may require use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in character of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 28, 2007, at Special Order Volume 71, Page 402, approving Transfer Application 10229, and together with Certificate 83125, supercedes Certificate 81896, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
