 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

TUMALO TOWN DISTRICT IMPROVEMENT COMPANY
 64682 COOK AVENUE #54
 BEND, OR 97701

confirms the right to use the waters of DESCHUTES RIVER, tributary to COLUMBIA RIVER for DOMESTIC USE AND IRRIGATION of 0.3 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 13245. The date of priority is AUGUST 25, 1938. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.0075 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS) FOR IRRIGATION AND 0.0118 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under an other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated FROM APRIL 1 TO MAY 22 OF EACH YEAR, ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated FROM MAY 23 TO AUGUST 20 OF EACH YEAR, and ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre for each acre irrigated AFTER AUGUST 20 OF EACH YEAR, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from APRIL 1 TO NOVEMBER 1.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point(s) of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.


When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 18, 2000, at Special Order Volume 54, Page 717, approving Transfer Application 7078, and together with Certificate 76619, supercedes Certificate 76464, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
