confirms the right to use the waters of FESSLER WELL 2 in PUDDING RIVER BASIN for GREENHOUSE USE AND IRRIGATION of 2.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-9587. The date of priority is MARCH 12, 1982. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.08 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.05 CFS FOR GREENHOUSE USE AND 0.03 CFS FOR IRRIGATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
