CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RICHARD E. AND NICKI I.WILHELM 105 ELLIOTT CREEK RD WILDERVILLE OR 97543

confirms the right to use the waters of SLATE CREEK, tributary to APPLEGATE RIVER for DOMESTIC USE AND IRRIGATION of 0.5 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit S-15751. The date of priority is APRIL 13, 1944.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

DOMESTIC USE is allowed year round and is limited to a rate not to exceed 0.003 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND and a total maximum volume of 1.8 ACRE-FEET PER YEAR.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 2 to October 31 of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

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The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with ODFW's operational and maintenance standards.

The water user shall maintain in-line flow restrictors.
