 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DALE GREEN
 1755 SAN SOUCI DR
 ROSEBURG OR 97470

confirms the right to use the waters of STOCKEL CREEK AND RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-5259, tributaries to SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 0.4 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit S-33276. The date of priority is MARCH 14, 1968. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion (POD) are located as follows:

27 S	6 W	WM	17	NW SW	RESERVOIR PUMP - 950 FEET SOUTH AND 1260 FEET EAST FROM W1/4 CORNER, SECTION 17

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from reservoir constructed under Permit R-5259.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The Director may require the water user to install a totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring devices at each point of diversion. If the Director notifies the water user to install totalizing flow meters or other measuring devices, the water user shall install such devices specified by the Director within the period allowed in the notice. Once installed, the water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order and shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install, maintain and operate a headgate to control and regulate the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered November 4, 2009, at Special Order Volume 79, Page 154, approving Transfer Application 10505, and supersedes Certificate 42652, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
