CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JEANNETTE M. CAPPELLA  
3430 QUARTZ CREEK RD  
MERLIN OR 97532

confirms the right to use the waters of QUARTZ CREEK, tributary to JUMPOFF JOE CREEK for DOMESTIC AND IRRIGATION OF 2.25 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1886.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.041 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (cfs) AND AS FURTHER DESCRIBED BELOW, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The year-round domestic use of water under this right is limited to a rate of 0.006 cfs and an annual volume limitation of 2.78 acre-feet.

The use of water for irrigation is limited to 0.031 cfs for irrigation of 2.25 acres during the irrigation season.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:


- A. The water user shall maintain the meter or other suitable measuring device in good working order.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION, PLACE OF USE AND CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 9, 2010, at Special Order Volume 81, Page 629, approving Transfer Application 11054, and together with Certificate 86486, supercedes Certificate 47291, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
