CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of WEAVER CREEK (UNNAMED STREAM), tributary to NORTH MYRTLE CREEK for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY.

This right was perfected under Permit 37043. The date of priority is JULY 13, 1972. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

28 S	4 W	WM	23	NW SE	450 FEET SOUTH & 2580 FEET WEST FROM E1/4 CORNER, SECTION 23

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 23, 2004, at Special Order Volume 60, Page 365, approving Transfer Applications 9390 and 9391, and together with Certificate 80769, supercedes Certificate 50790, State record of Water Right Certificates.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
