CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

KRAEMERS NURSERY INC. 13523 MARQUAM RD NE MT ANGEL OR 97362

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS within the ZOLLNER CREEK BASIN for PRIMARY IRRIGATION OF 1.7 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 1.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under PERMIT G-7296. The date of priority is MARCH 4, 1977. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.015 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation (wells), shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation described as follows:

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm CHANGES IN POINT OF APPROPRIATION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 25, 1999, at Special Order Volume 53, Page 774, approving Transfer Application 6868 and together with 72940 supersedes Certificate 72940.

Note that Special Order Volume 53, Page 774, approving Transfer Application 6868 indicated the change in point of appropriation allowed under Transfer 6440 was not completed; however Certificate 72940 was issued to confirm the change allowed under Transfer 6440.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
