CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

R DOUGLAS POWELL 6153 MILL CREEK RD THE DALLES OR 97058

confirms the right to use the waters of MILL CREEK, tributary to COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 8.7 ACRES AND STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Wasco County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 8, at Page 119. The date of priority is 1855.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.145 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-SIXTIETH of one cubic foot per second, per acre during the irrigation season from APRIL 1 TO OCTOBER 1; and ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second for each one thousand head of stock, if available at the original point of diversion.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

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Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 17, 2001, at Special Order Volume 55, Page 1325, approving Transfer Application 8639, and together with Certificate 79015, supercedes Certificate 5722, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
