 CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH FORK WALLA WALLA RIVER, tributary to WALLA WALLA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 7.1 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UMATILLA County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 12, at Page 9. The date of priority is 1882.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed ONE AND ONE-HALF MINERS INCHES PER ACRE (0.266 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point(s) of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.


The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

Certificate 88098 was issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 9, 2004, at Special Order Volume 61, Page 22, approving Transfer Application 9197, and together with Certificate 80880, superseded Certificate 13146, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

This certificate is issued to correct a scrivener's error in the certificate number. Certificate 88098 was used two times by the Department. This certificate is issued to supersede certificate 88098.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
