CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MICHAEL AND TARA BROADBENT
15870 BARCLAY DR
SISTERS OR 97759

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in WHYCHUS CREEK BASIN for IRRIGATION of 2.25 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-11250. The date of priority is DECEMBER 17, 1990. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.028 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

15 S	10 E	WM	4	SW NE	1217 FEET NORTH AND 1259 FEET EAST FROM C ¹ / ₄ CORNER, SECTION 4

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation described as follows:

15 S	10 E	WM	3	SW NW	1425 FEET SOUTH AND 238 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 3

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation

The water user shall maintain an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This use may be regulated if analysis of data available discloses that the appropriation will measurably reduce the surface water flows necessary to maintain the free-flowing character of a scenic waterway in quantities necessary for recreation, fish and wildlife in effect as of the priority date of this right or as those quantities may be subsequently reduced.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.


The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN POINT OF APPROPRIATION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 3, 2004, at Special Order Volume 60, Page 24, approving Transfer Application 9522, and together with Certificate 80627, supercedes Certificate 79636, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
