confirms the right to use the waters of EAST AND WEST BRANCHES OF THE CROCKETT BRANCH OF THE LITTLE WALLA RIVER, tributary to WALLA WALLA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 6.53 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 12, at Page 9. The dates of priority are 1892 FOR 2.61 ACRES, 1898 FOR 1.96 ACRES AND 1903 FOR 1.96 ACRES.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 9.79 MINERS INCHES (0.24 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE AND ONE-HALF MINER'S INCHES PER ACRES, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion (POD), shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available from the original point of diversion described as follows:



6 N	35 E	WM	26	SW NE	EAST BRANCH POD - 22 FEET NORTH AND 1316 FEET EAST FROM THE S ¼ CORNER

When required by the Department, the water user or irrigation district shall operate and maintain the headgate and measuring device, as needed. The water user or irrigation district shall report total flow figures when requested by the Watermaster. The Watermaster may operate the headgate and monitor accuracy of the measuring device, as needed.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered September 15, 1998, at Special Order Volume 52, Page 827, approving Transfer Application 7153, and together with Certificate 75799, supercedes Certificate 13175, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
