CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DOUGLAS FRANK 8940 HOLLAND LOOP RD CAVE JUNCTION OR 97523

confirms the right to use the waters of SUCKER CREEK, a tributary of EAST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER, FOR IRRIGATION OF 4.8 ACRES, STOCK, AND DOMESTIC FOR TRACT #1, AND IRRIGATION OF 1.3 ACRES FOR TRACT #4.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 229, Volume 5, at Page 420, Volume 5, at Page 394. The date of priority is 1857 for TRACT #1 AND 1908 for TRACT #4.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.096 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS) FOR TRACT #1 AND 0.016 CFS FOR TRACT #4, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source, and that the use of said water for irrigation purposes shall be confined to the irrigation season APRIL 1 TO OCTOBER 31 each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

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The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (sump), shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a properly functioning totalizing flow meter for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered APRIL 18, 2003, at Special Order Volume 57, Page 452, approving Transfer Application 9047, and together with Certificate 79996 and Certificates confirming Transfer Applications 8620, 8471, 8918, and 9048, supercedes Certificate 7139, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
