CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

SCIONTI/LANDT FAMILY TRUST RICK LANDT AND LYNNE SCIONTI, TRUSTEES 468 HELMAN ST ASHLAND OR 97520

confirms the right to use the waters of ASHLAND CREEK, tributary to BEAR CREEK for IRRIGATION OF 0.5 ACRE AND STOCK.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1864.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.008 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The Director may require the water user to install a totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring devices at each point of diversion. If the Director notifies the water user to install totalizing flow meters or other measuring devices, the water user shall install such devices specified by the Director within the period allowed in the notice. Once installed, the water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order and shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install, maintain and operate a headgate to control and regulate the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

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This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MARCH 26, 2010, at Special Order Volume 80, Page 514, approving Transfer Application 10815, and together with Certificate 86144, supercedes Certificate 16035, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
