CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOHN SALLSTROM
MT.HOOD, OR 97041

confirms the right to use the waters of FOUR SMALL SPRINGS for IRRIGATION of 5.5 ACRES and DOMESTIC.

This right was perfected under Permit 9052. The date of priority is MAY 14, 1929. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.055 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), or the equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

TWP	RNG	MER	SEC	Q - Q
1 N	10 E	W.M.	27	S½ SW NW

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH (1/80) of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 10033, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on April 25th, 2013, and recorded in Special Order Volume 89, Pages 414 to 429, approving a petition by Mt. Hood Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district.

This certificate, together with certificate 88172 supersedes water right certificate 10033 in the name of John Sallstrom.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
