confirms the right to use the waters of BALDWIN CREEK, a tributary of EAST FORK HOOD RIVER, for the use of 0.114 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 9.10 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Hood River County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 6, at Page 200. The date of priority is 1890.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for the described purposes and shall not exceed ONE-EIGHTIETH (1/80) of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, measured at the point of diversion.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 14960, State Record of Water Right Certificates, diminished from irrigation to supplemental irrigation by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on April 25,2013, and recorded in Special Order Volume 89, Pages 414 to 429, approving a petition by Mt. Hood Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate, together with Certificate 88173, supersedes water right certificate 14960 in the name of J. B. Doggett.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in the decree.
