CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of SPRINGS for 0.025 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 2.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Hood River County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 6, at Page 200. The date of priority is 1888.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for the described purposes and shall not exceed ONE-EIGHTIETH (1/80) of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 15040, State Record of Water Right Certificates, diminished from irrigation to supplemental irrigation by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on April 25th, 2013, and recorded in Special Order Volume 89, Pages 414 to 429, approving a petition by Mt. Hood Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district.

This certificate supersedes water right certificate 15040 in the name of Clarissa Welch.

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations in said decree.
