CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GB ENTERPRISES LLC
21 C ORINDA WAY 308
ORINDA CA 94563

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL #2 (LINN 54762), WELL #3 (LINN 10651), AND WELL #4 (LINN 56115) in OWL CREEK BASIN (WILLAMETTE RIVER) for IRRIGATION of 4.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-1573. The date of priority is APRIL 12, 1960. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.057 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of appropriation (wells), shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation described as follows:

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.


The Director may require the water user to install a totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring devices at each point of appropriation. If the Director notifies the water user to install totalizing flow meters or other measuring devices, the water user shall install such devices specified by the Director within the period allowed in the notice. Once installed, the water user shall maintain the meters or measuring devices in good working order and shall allow the Watermaster access to the meters or measuring devices.

This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN POINT OF APPROPRIATION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JULY 27, 2010, at Special Order Volume 81, Page 535, approving Transfer Application 10400, and together with Certificate 86446, supercedes Certificate 32460, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
