CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

FRANK AND LAUREN SPROUL
52899 BIG CREEK RD
MYRTLE POINT OR 97458

confirms the right to use the waters of BIG CREEK, tributary to MIDDLE FORK COQUILLE RIVER for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE HOUSEHOLD.

This right was perfected under Permit S-16439. The date of priority is JULY 23, 1945. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.006 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, FURTHER LIMITED TO 2.5 ACRE-FEET PER YEAR, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

29 S	11 W	WM	22	NE SE	SOUTH 88 DEGREES WEST, 400 FEET FROM E1/4 CORNER, SECTION 22

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point(s) of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the totalizing flow meter or other suitable measuring device in good working order.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain and operate the fish screen and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

This certificate is issued to confirm a CHANGE IN POINT OF DIVERSION, PLACE OF USE, AND CHARACTER OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 18, 2010, at Special Order Volume 80, Page 1011, approving Transfer Application 10783, and together with Certificate 86311, supercedes Certificate 26280, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
