confirms the right to use the waters of LITTLE APPLGATE RIVER, tributary to APPLGATE RIVER for IRRIGATION of 9.6 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Jackson County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1885.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.24 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion (POD) are located as follows:

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion, together with that diverted at the old points of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original points of diversion described as GALLAGHER DITCH.

The water user shall maintain headgates, in-line flow meters, weirs, or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

When requested by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water available at the original points of diversion. The types and plans of measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.


Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain fish screens or fish by-pass devices.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in POINTS OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered April 20, 1998, at Special Order Volume 52, Page 403, approving Transfer Application 6738, and supercedes a portion of Certificate 16403, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
