CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LINDA McARTHUR
DAYVILLE, OR 97825

confirms the right to use the waters of the SOUTH FORK JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary to the JOHN DAY RIVER for IRRIGATION of 1.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-11192. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 23, 1934. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.025 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q - Q
13 S	26 E	WM	13	NW SE

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated prior to June 1st, and thereafter ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated, or its equivalent, and shall not exceed ONE-ACRE FOOT per acre during any month prior to June 1, nor exceed a total during the irrigation season from April 1 to September 30, of each year of FOUR-ACRE FEET per acre.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 12096, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered May 8 2013, approving Transfer Application T-10938.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
