CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ROBERT D AND DELORRIS GOSS  
701 S 18TH ST  
LA GRANDE OR 97850

confirms the right to use the waters of SPRINGS AND A HYDRAULICALLY CONNECTED WELL, tributaries to TAYLOR CREEK for IRRIGATION of 20.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 6943. The date of priority is AUGUST 18, 1925. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.25 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

3 S	38 E	WM	17	SE NE	20.0

The quantity of water diverted at the new points of diversion, together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm an ADDITIONAL POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 15, 1997, at Special Order Volume 51, Page 463, approving Transfer Application 7621, and supercedes Certificate 6717, State record of Water Right Certificates.
