CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of WILLOW CREEK, tributary to COLUMBIA RIVER for IRRIGATION of 20.6 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Gilliam County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 1, at Page 73. The date of priority is 1903.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.34 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Twp	Rng	Mer	Sec	Q-Q	Measured Distances
3 N	22 E	WM	23	SW NW	1720 FEET SOUTH & 650 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER, SECTION 23

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-SIXTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season, being March 1st to September 1st of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JULY 10, 2002, at Special Order Volume 56, Page 647, approving Transfer Application 8529, and supercedes a portion of Certificate 182, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
