## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DAVID & CARLA HUGIE PO BOX 1235 SHADY COVE OR 97539

confirms the right to use the waters of ROGUE RIVER, tributary to PACIFIC OCEAN for IRRIGATION of 11.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 49500. The date of priority is AUGUST 29, 1985 FOR 0.08 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND AND OCTOBER 18, 1985 FOR 0.06 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.14 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface water source as the original point of diversion.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered NOVEMBER 6, 1996, at Special Order Volume 50, Page 792, approving Transfer Application 7555, and together with Certificate 73399, supersedes Certificate 64957, State record of Water Right Certificates.
