CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL, within the BEAR CREEK BASIN for IRRIGATION of 22.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10114. The date of priority is MAY 31, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 67.3 GALLONS PER MINUTE (0.15 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND), or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

4 S	1 E	WM	27	SW SW	43	340 FEET NORTH & 1170 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER, SECTION 27

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

Use of water under this right is limited to the appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not reduce the flow of Bear Creek.


The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered DECEMBER 5, 2001, at Special Order Volume 55, Page 1278, approving Transfer Application 8555, and together with Certificate 78603, supercedes Certificate 64345, State record of Water Right Certificates.
