CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of SUCKER CREEK, tributary to EAST FORK ILLINOIS RIVER for IRRIGATION of 21.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volumes 1 and 5, at Pages 254 and 399. The date of priority is 1872 FOR TRACT 1 AND 1908 FOR TRACT 2.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.26 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) FOR TRACT 1 AND 0.10 CFS FOR TRACT 2; AND THAT THE USE OF WATER FOR IRRIGATION PURPOSES SHALL BE CONFINED TO THE SEASON APRIL 1ST TO OCTOBER 31ST OF EACH YEAR, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of diversion described as follows:

39 S	7 W	WM	29	NW SE	1580 FEET NORTH AND 1000 FEET EAST FROM S1/4 CORNER, SECTION 29 (WILLIAMS DITCH)

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW


This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered FEBUARY 26, 2008, at Special Order Volume 74, Page 264, approving Transfer Application 10211, and supersedes Certificate 7160, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
