CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILLIAM BUXBAUM, MICHAEL SCHNEIDER, AND LIVIJA SCHNEIDER
17624 NORTH APPLGATE RD
GRANTS PASS OR 97527

confirms the right to use the waters of APPLGATE LAKE RESERVOIR, CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-7810, tributary to APPLGATE RIVER for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 38.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit S-46019. The date of priority is JULY 23, 1981. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 38.0 ACRE FEET OF STORED WATER ONLY, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion (POD) are located as follows:

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein, and is subject to the terms and conditions of Contract No. 1-07-10-W0300, or a satisfactory replacement, between the Bureau of Reclamation and the applicant, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Department.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Water shall be acquired from the same surface source as the original point of diversion.


The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm an additional point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered August 16, 2000, at Special Order Volume 54, Page 584, approving Transfer Application 8327, and supercedes Certificate 65595, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
