CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

HAROLD J. AND JUDITH E. FARVER 3787 EAST FORK RD WILLIAMS OR 97544-9713

confirms the right to use the waters of EAST FORK WILLIAMS CREEK, tributary to WILLIAMS CREEK for IRRIGATION of 8.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Josephine County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 4, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1889.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.16 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A description of the place of use is as follows:

The new point of diversion must take water from the same source as the old points of diversion. The old points of diversion shall no longer be used under these rights to irrigate the lands transferred under this order.

The water user shall maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

The water user shall maintain a fish screening and/or by-pass device, as appropriate, at the point of diversion consistent with Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife's operational and maintenance standards.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on place of use described, and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482. Pursuant to ORS 183.482, ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review and petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered SEPTEMBER 14, 2006, at Special Order Volume 70, Page 192, approving Transfer Application 10147, and together with Certificate 82378, supercedes Certificate 16331, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
